Reports are delivered to the ordering provider and the patient within 24–48 hours.

Patients may self-submit an itemized receipt to their plan or HSA/FSA administrator for possible reimbursement, which is never guaranteed. Please tell patients this before referring.

2 Give the signed form to your patient
